All applicants are limited to winning no more than two scholarship awards from Teamsters Credit Union.

Scholarship awards must be claimed by the qualifying winner and disbursed by the credit union in the calendar year in which they are awarded. Payment is made by reimbursement to the recipient upon the submission of paid receipts. If these charges add up to less than \$500 or \$1,000, an award of such lesser amount will be made. Payment can also be made directly to the school upon receipt of school bill.
